Eligibility Requirements

Before proceeding to apply for The Jayson Tatum Foundation Zero Limits Scholarship, please ensure you meet the following eligibility requirements:

- A graduating high school senior in the class of 2023/2024 who lives in St. Louis County, St. Louis City, or East St. Louis.
- Eligible students must be admitted and plan to enroll full-time into an accredited 2 or 4 year college/university or trade school* in the Fall semester of the 2024/2025 academic school year.
- Eligible for Federal Pell Grant.

Needed for Application Completion

You can start your application, save and come back to complete it at any time. However, it's helpful to gather all the information you need so you can finish the application in one sitting.

- High School Administrative Contact (Principal, Counselor, etc)
- List of Honors / Awards you've received
- List of Extracurricular Activity Participation
- List of Any Work History
- List of Any Volunteer History
- Names & Contact Information for 2-3 References
- Upload your High School Transcript
- Upload Proof of Acceptance/Enrollment into Post Secondary Education
- Upload Essay, Pdf or Video (Download Essay Guide)
- Financial Aid Award Letter from Institution you Plan to Attend (if you've received it)
- Free Application for Federal Student Aid Submission Summary (FAFSA FSS) (if you received it)

** TRADE SCHOOLS DISCLAIMER: If tuition and supplies (as required by the trade school) to an accredited and reputable "trade school" is less than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) per year – for the first (freshman) year -- the JTF Zero Limits Scholarship award for that first year of attendance at the trade school will be for the amount of tuition and supplies ONLY.*
